Fri, Aug. 6 ♥ Depart New York in the evening to Rio De Janeiro.

Sat, Aug. 7 ♥ Arrive Rio De Janeiro. Group will be met by local guide and transferred to hotel. Upon arrival, time to freshen up and store luggage with concierge before departing on afternoon city and Sugar Loaf tour. The first stop will be at a local restaurant for a typical "Churrascaria" meal. Then drive through downtown Rio, past its fine collection of colonial-style Portuguese buildings, to pick up the cable car at Prai Vermelha (red beach). The cable car takes you to the top of Sugar Loaf Mountain for wonderful views of Rio de Janeiro nestling between the mountains and the sea, and the magical sight of the sun dipping down over Copacabana beach. After tour, return to hotel and check in.

Sun, Aug. 8 ♥ This morning tour starts with a trip to the Cosme Velho station to catch the cog train. The train journey takes you through the dense Atlantic rain forest of Tijuca to the statue of Christ the Redeemer on Corcovado Mountain. Spend time enjoying the sights of Rio from this soaring mountain-top vantage point. Return along the coast, passing by Rio's celebrated beaches.

Mon, Aug. 9 ♥ Mid morning transfer to the airport for flight to Salvador. Upon arrival in Salvador, transfer to hotel and check in. Rest of the day at leisure

Tue, Aug. 10 ♥ Full day tour of Salvador visiting the main historical sites! Visit the Museu Náutico da Bahia (Nautical Museum), Forte de Santa Maria, and Forte São Diogo. And Pelourinho, the highlight of our tour, designated by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site because it holds the most important colonial architecture in the world from the XVII and XVIII centuries. In addition to the many beautiful churches, such as Igreja de São Francisco, group will visit the squares, monuments and important museums of Pelourinho. After lunch group will visit the famous Bonfim church, which holds several different religious manifestations and where the famous feast of Lavagem do Bonfim takes place (when the steps of the church are washed). The last part of our tour is devoted to visit the famous Forte de São Marcelo where the magnificent view of Baía de Todos os Santos makes the visit unforgettable.

Wed, Aug. 11 ♥ Full day optional tour to the islands of the Baía de Todos os Santos on a schooner, stopping off for lunch at the island of Itaparica. The largest and fairest bay along the Brazilian coast, All Saints Bay amazes visitors because of the numerous tropical islands with enchanting beaches and lush vegetation and because great historical treasures dot the landscape: churches, forts, beautiful colonial mansions and plantation houses from the times when Brazil was still under Portuguese rule.

Thu, Aug. 12 ♥ Full day tour visiting the beautiful town of Cachoeira and the Recôncavo Baiano region! Soak in the city's unique history and colorful, mostly preserved colonial architecture. Cachoeira has one of the most important architectural complexes of Latin America. Handicrafts, cuisine and folklore are unique throughout this region. Tour also includes a visit to the town's churches - Igreja Matriz and the Ordem Terceira do Carmo.

Fri, Aug. 13 ♥ The day is free to pursue individual interest. This evening enjoy a Group Farewell Dinner with a folkloric show. Nights in Bahia are a real spectacle. Group will visit one of the most traditional show houses in Salvador. In this typical and enchanting atmosphere you will taste a buffet with a wide variety of Bahian cuisine, while watching a folkloric show performing some of the main Afro-Bahian cultural expressions such as samba-de-roda, maculelê, hauling of the fishnet, Candomblé and Capoeira.

Sat, Aug. 14 ♥ Mid morning transfer to the airport for flight to Rio De Janeiro. Upon arrival, transfer to connecting flight to US.

Sun, Aug. 15 ♥ Arrive JFK in the morning.

CANCELLATIONS: \$150.00 per person will be levied for cancellations received prior to 91 days before departure date. No refunds due to tax surcharge increases.** Refunds will not be given in the case of air transportation tax increases.
