3 Feb. 11:35am South African Airways departs JFK airport to Johannesburg.

4 Feb. 8:45am arrival in Johannesburg International airport. Transfer to flight to Cape Town. Arrive Cape Town, transfer to hotel.

5 Feb. Visit Cape Point at the tip of the African continent, where it is said that the two oceans, the Indian and Atlantic meet. Continue to visit the penguins on Boulders Beach and then end at Spier Wine Estate in the heart of the Stellenbosch Winelands, one of the most beautiful parts of the world. Enjoy a tour of the Estate, wine-tasting and lunch.

6 Feb. Enjoy a full day Township tour. Townships came about during Apartheid when the government allocated land for the construction of thousands of two-room houses. Visit District Six Museum. Discover the sad but also positive history of Cape Town and its people. View lifestyles affected by the many years of Apartheid.

7 Feb. Visit Table Mountain. Then continue onto the V&A Waterfront for free time. Enjoy lunch at one of the local Waterfront restaurants before boarding the ferry to Robben Island, a World Heritage Site. The island became infamous during South Africa's years under Apartheid rule. The government banished dissidents and political prisoners to the island, the most famous one being former president, Nelson Mandela.

8 Feb. Midday flight to Johannesburg. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel.

9 Feb. Visit Soweto, South Africa's most famous Township, followed by lunch. Then visit the Apartheid Museum which offers a look at the harrowing conditions in which black Africans, Indians, and mixed-race "coloreds" were forced to live.

10 Feb. Depart to Sun City. Free time to explore the pleasures of Sun City, an enormous, extravagantly opulent complex of hotels, gaming rooms, theaters, restaurants, bars, discos and shop all set in spacious and beautifully landscaped grounds. Depart at 4pm to the Lodge. Enjoy an evening game drive and dinner at the lodge.

11 Feb. Morning game drive. Checkout and transfer to Johannesburg with lunch enroute at Carnivore's. Continue to airport for flight to NY at 7:20pm.

12 Feb. Arrive New York, JFK Airport at 6:55am.

Details will be mailed upon receipt of initial deposit. Passengers are responsible for ascertaining, obtaining and having with them passports, visas and all other required documents. No refunds will be made to any passenger whose participation is limited or denied due to failure to process required documents.

DEPOSITS: Reservations are only considered definite upon receipt of a **\$500.00, per person deposit** by check/money order made payable to E-Z TOURS. Reservation coupon must be signed. There is no due date for deposits, however space is limited. Reservations will be confirmed on a first-come-first-served basis. All deposits must be paid by check or money order only, no credits cards. **Payment of deposit signifies full acceptance of terms and conditions set forth in this brochure.**

FINAL PAYMENT: Final payment due **December 3, 2010**. Final payment must include airline taxes that are not included in the tour rate. A late fee of \$100.00 will be levied for any tour not paid in full by December 3, 2010. If payment is not received in full by December 15, 2010 (including all taxes & any applicable late fees) E-Z Tours will assume cancellation due to non-payment. CREDIT CARDS: If you would like to pay the South African air portion of the tour by credit card, please indicate your preference on the Reservation Coupon and details will be mailed upon receipt of initial deposit. Amount: \$1480.00 plus tax.

CANCELLATIONS: A fee of \$150.00 per person will be levied for all cancellations received prior to 121 days before departure date. Cancellations received 120-61 days prior to departure will be levied \$500.00. There will be no refunds given for cancellations received 60-0 days prior to departure. No refunds due to tax surcharge increases. Refunds will not be given in the case of air transportation tax increases. Refunds are only processed upon receipt of a written request, the postmark of which determines date of cancellation. If payment is not received in full by February 10, 2010 (including any applicable late fees) E-Z Tours will assume cancellation due to non-payment.
